At Jct 21A on the M1 take A46 towards Newark  
After 6 miles take A6 towards Loughborough  
After 3 miles at roundabout turn left towards Mountsorrel/Quorn  
At roundabout turn right towards Quorn  
At mini roundabout turn left into Wood Lane  
Hotel is ½ mile on the left hand side

From the north and west

At Jct 23 on the M1 take A512 towards Loughborough  
In ½ mile at traffic lights turn right towards Nanpantan  
At Priory Pub traffic lights go straight on towards Woodhouse Eaves  
At T-junction in 2 miles turn left  
In 2 miles at traffic lights turn right towards the centre of Quorn  
Proceed over bumps and at 3<sup>rd</sup> mini roundabout turn right into Wood Lane towards Swithland.  
Hotel is ½ mile on the left hand side

From the east

Take the A46 to the A6 junction and follow directions from the south
